Contribution (s) Bob broke a number of corporate “glass ceilings” to become one of the highest Chinese American executive in the former Bell telephone system, or “Ma Bell”. He was the chief marketing officer at Pacific Telesis at the time of the breakup of AT&T and later became a corporate Executive Vice President and President of Business Communications before retiring in 1998.

He currently serves on three corporate Boards of Directors. In addition, he has been active in several non-profit organizations, such as former Chair of Youth Tennis Advantage, which serves Bay Area inner city kids with tennis and tutoring. He was the former Chair of the Committee 100 for four years in which he provided leadership to expand the influence of C-100 in improving US-China relations.
