He has published over 30 technical papers and two books: “Insider’s View of Intel” (1995) and “Creating the Digital Future” (1998).

As Senior Vice President for Intel, Dr. Yu was able to strategize the development of six microprocessors, from 386TM to the Pentium 4 processor. Largely through his development and leadership, Intel has experienced enormous growth. Its products were featured in the majority of systems throughout the world. His chips have helped Intel become the largest semiconductor company in the world. He has also been involved with Intel’s entry into the optoelectronics business as well as its international expansions.

Dr. Yu is now Chairman of OneAngstrom LLC. He is still active investing and mentoring high technology companies. He sits on the boards of Stanford, Berkeley, and the Tech Museum. He is a member of Committee 100.
