Poon has been largely responsible for Johnson & Johnson's rise as a global pharmaceuticals company. She is responsible for managing the pharmaceutical, consumer pharmaceutical, and nutritional businesses of the company, in addition to overseeing its expanding R&D pipeline. Pharmaceuticals are now the fastest growing sector in the Johnson & Johnson Company. According to Forbes Magazine Poon is the top-seated woman—and one of the most respected—in the industry.

Before joining Johnson & Johnson, Poon worked at Bristol-Myers-Squibb for 15 years and was head of Bristol-Myers-Squibb's medical equipment division in 1997 and then head of their international medicine division from 1998 to 2000. In November 2000, she joined Johnson & Johnson as Company Group Chairman in pharmaceuticals. She was promoted to the Executive Committee and named Worldwide Chairman, Pharmaceuticals in 2001.
